Elie Roth Scholarship for Personal and Professional Development

ONBIDA's **Elie Roth Scholarship** is aimed at providing funding for students, individuals in education or related fields, parents or persons with dyslexia to enhance their understanding of dyslexia and intervention strategies. In 2009 five scholarships will be available to cover registration fees only, for the ONBIDA Conference, May 2, 2009. Scholarship applications will be assessed by the Scholarship Adjudication Committee and will be awarded based on the information in the personal statement. ***The statement should indicate your interest in dyslexia and related learning disabilities, your need for personal and/or professional development in this area and how you hope this conference will contribute to your personal or professional goals (Limit 250 words).*** If you pre-register and then become the recipient of a scholarship, your registration fee will be refunded. Scholarship deadline is March 15, 2009. Recipients will be notified by March 30th. ONBIDA reserves the right to make determinations as to an applicant's eligibility.
